Unfortunately, if NOT completed and returned by 31st January 2024, we will have no choice but to remove all details we hold for you from our records. This means that even if you renew your membership by Standing Order every year, we cannot hold any contact information for you without a completed OPT IN form. This includes the Magazine distribution information. **If you subsequently wish to re-instate your contact details, you should contact the Membership Secretary.**

All new members will be required to complete this [OPT IN Consent](#) on joining DAGFAS and the Society will repeat this process, updating its records every five years.
