General Data Protection Regulation

DUMFRIES AND GALLOWAY FINE ARTS SOCIETY (DAGFAS) aims to promote the Fine Arts and Artistic Crafts and foster and encourage the practice and appreciation of drawing, painting, emerging arts and associated Artistic Crafts across the region.

In order to take the Society forward we need to ensure that the information held is accurate, up to date and compliant with current regulations and data requirements. To retain Membership data and distribute information to Members other than at Committee or AGM Meetings DAGFAS requires **OPT IN Consent** from individuals.

All personal information gathered is stored securely; only be used by DAGFAS representatives; is not shared with any other organisation (emails are only ever blind copied and remain private); and information is available to inspect, update or remove on request.

We therefore require your help by confirming your continued **OPT IN consent** and details held by completing this form.
